Sid the Seagull recommends

- Slip on some sun-protective clothing that covers as much skin as possible.
- **Slop** on broad spectrum, water resistant SPF30+ (or higher) sunscreen. Put it on 20 minutes before you go outdoors and every two hours afterwards. Sunscreen should never be used to extend the time you spend in the sun.
- Slap on a hat broad brim or legionnaire style to protect your face, head, neck and ears.
- Seek shade.
- Slide on some sunglasses!
- Drinking water is an important part of staying healthy, especially when it's hot outside.

Honey Bees Nursery Integrated Class

Honey Bee students had their first water play lesson under the supervision of swimming teachers and support from class teachers and office staff. Butterfly Nursery/K1 International Class

May has been another super busy month for Nursery K1 International Butterfly Class. We have been learning about lots of different types of transportation; land, air and water vehicles! We have also been learning about traffic lights and how they keep us safe on the roads. Our favorite modes of transport are motorbikes, hot air balloons and submarines!





Panda K1 Integrated Class

Monkeys K2 International Class

For our transport topic, Monkey class got busy making paper mache hot air balloons. The children each had a balloon and some newspaper. First they ripped the newspaper into small pieces and then applied one layer of newspaper and one layer of white paper using the glue paste. Once the balloons were dry they decorated their balloons to make them look bright and colorful like hot air balloons. Then we attached a basket to the balloon using string and hung them up. They had so much fun with this activity and had such a sense of achievement at the end once they saw the finished results.





Tigers Prep International Class

The month of May has been all about how we can take care of and help our planet. In the previous month we learned about different bodies of water and water ways. Knowing that the rivers in Ha Noi will flow into the ocean, we discussed how we can help keep our waterways clean here in Ha Noi in order to prevent this. We learned what products and materials are harmful to the planet as well as the creatures living on it. We took the time to brainstormed what we can try to do to prevent the massive amounts of trash we see here in the city. We learned all about recycling, reusing, reducing, and composting. The children have an understanding of the harmful affects of plastic and other products that cannot be broken down naturally. The children had the pleasure of learning about the famous anthropologist, Jane Goodall. They loved seeing how she studied and cared deeply for the chimpanzees.







Cubs Prep Integrated Class
