Prep International – Tiger Class

We are having a lovely and very busy Third Term! We are working very hard and learned about “The Solar System, the Earth, Endangered Animals and how to take care of animals and the food chain.

We have started practicing for the end of year concert! The children are very excited about it.

Ms. Loan and Tae Jun had their birthdays this month. Congratulations!

We also go to T-Park on Wednesdays. The children enjoy this very much! It is an opportunity for children to play, practice what they are learning in class, use their language and problem solving skills.

We have started with a “Reading Program” in the morning before snack time. Children have started to read, copy and write short sentences.

We are busy with adding and subtracting in Mathematics. The children are working on worksheets as well as in their Math books. We have also started to recognize 3D Shapes.

In Vietnamese, we have learnt about the Seasons, different fruit and flowers and celebrated Women’s day during the Vietnamese lessons. The International children’s Vietnamese language skills have improved much and they enjoy these lessons enormously! They have also started to count and learn the different shapes in Vietnamese.





Prep Integrated – Cubs Class

What a busy term we have had. This term we have been learning all about the Solar System and our Earth.

The children in the Prep Cubs class have really enjoyed learning about rockets and the planets. As part of learning about the Earth, the children have investigated how we need to care for and look after not only the earth, but animals and their habitats.

A highlight of our week is our nature walks to T-section park/playground each Wednesday morning. The children love this time, it gives them an opportunity to practice their English language skills. It also means we have an opportunity to further explore different concepts we have been learning in the classroom.

In the last two weeks, we have started investigating trees. During our weekly visits to the park, we have decided to document the trees there. This means measuring, drawing, and taking photos of the trees. The children have particularly been interested in measurements.

We have measured each student in our class, and at least once a week we have to re-check their heights. This is done using blocks, duplo, lego and rulers.

We are also busy getting ready for Year1, which means the children have been practicing their letters and sounds, handwriting, sight words, reading short sentences, recognizing numbers and other mathematical concepts - addition and subtraction, shapes and colors to name a few.
