**STEM**

Our beautiful STEM room is now complete and we have all the equipment to run UBITECH and MAKEBLOCK with our students. Our students are using iPads to follow instructions and learn how to do programming. Our students are really enjoying these STEM activities. Next Semester, we will offer STEM as a club as students will get to program our Robot.

**DYNED**

Please encourage your children to work on their DynEd program at home, as this will help improve their English skills. Students work at their own pace and will be issued a Certificate from DynEd when they reach any stage between A1 - C2. Our High School students should achieve a C2 by the end of the school year, and this will support their enrolment to Universities as a C2 score is equivalent to a 8-9 IELTS score.
