We thank you for your support! Thank you for sharing with us the delights of your child's development. We feel a strong connection to our family and wish you the best.

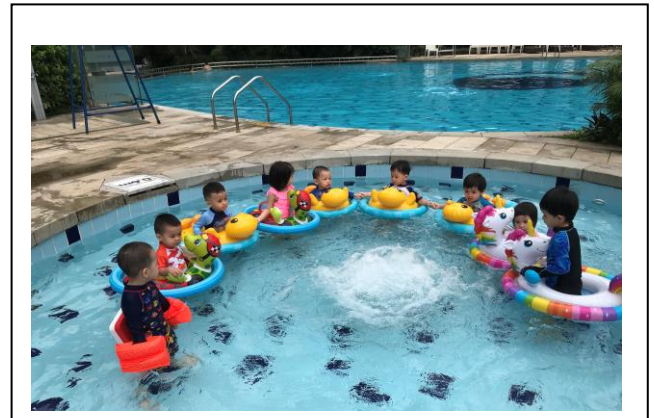




## Pre-Nursery/Nursery Integrated

Our Children's Day event was a blast! The students had great fun moving to places to try different games and activities and were excited over their presents.





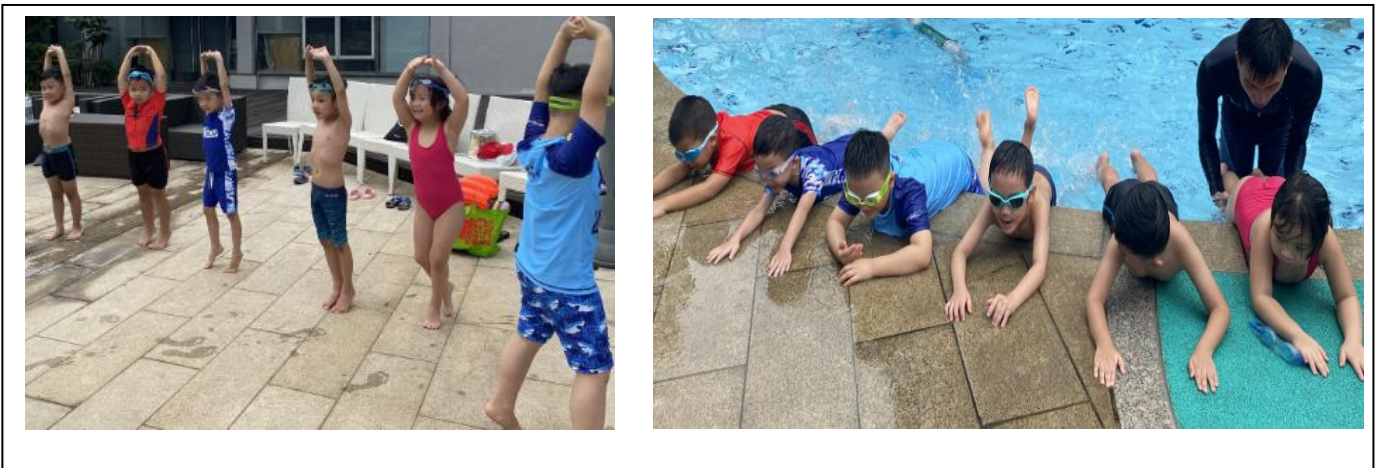
Hands-on activities, mapping exercises, interactive games and songs helped our students remember and deliver the contents of our show and tell. Check out some of our videos on Class Dojo.

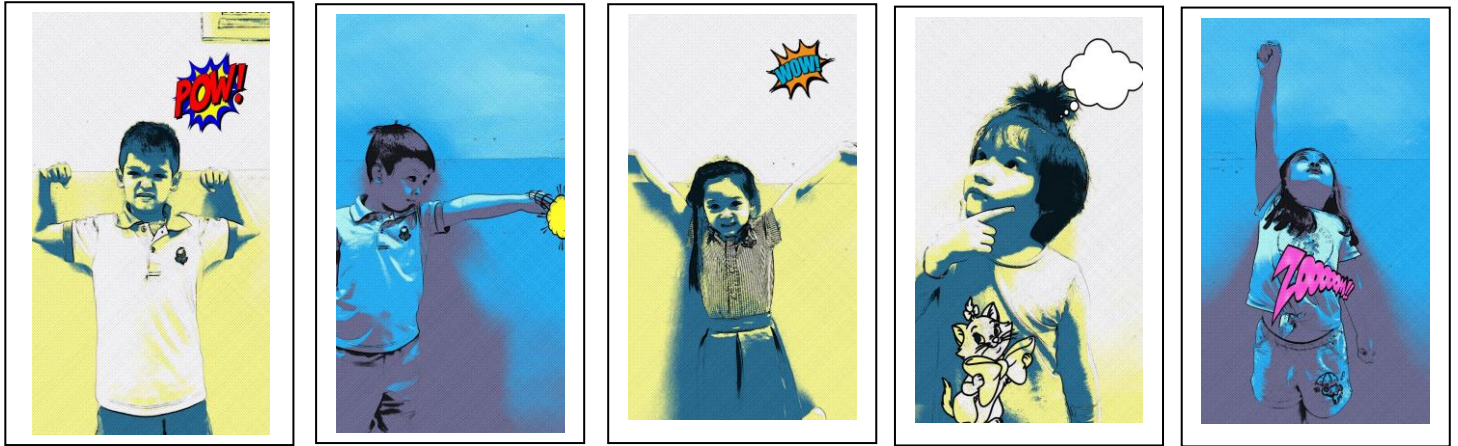

Greetings from K2 International,

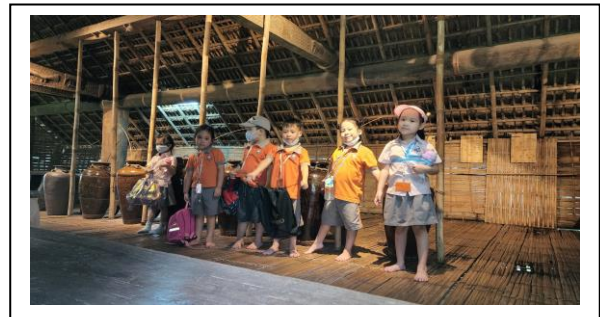
We have had a very busy week with lots of fun activities.
