This shows that students are not only finding near-perfect success with average or above average scores, but we have also continued to carry some of the best results in all eight years of the program for the A-A* category. Of those, two students achieved all A-A* marks. Nine students had A-A* for over half of all their IGCSEs.

Year 8L Science: When angels get mesmerized by osmosis

Did you know that angels too, get mesmerized by science?

Well, that is exactly what happened during a recent science lesson with year 8L pupils at Singapore International School, Vung Tau.

In 90 minutes of curiosity in the science laboratory, the little angels discovered that science and size matter. The pupils were carrying out a science investigation on osmosis using dialysis tubing. Osmosis has many applications in real life, such as in medicine and in preservation of fruits and meat.

Dialysis tubing is a semi-permeable membrane. It allows small molecules, such as water, to pass through easily, while larger molecules, such as sucrose, are restricted. Movement of molecules across the tubing is due to concentration gradients. In their experiment designed to study osmosis, several pieces of dialysis tubing were filled with sucrose solutions of varying concentration and placed in beakers containing distilled water. These were then placed in a water-bath for 15 minutes.

What the angels found was mesmerizing - water molecules pass from an area of high concentration to an area of low concentration across a semi-permeable membrane. Small molecules, such as water, pass through easily, while larger molecules, such as sucrose, are restricted.

This is called osmosis. And yes, in osmosis, size matters!
