As we welcome 2025, we are excited to celebrate the vibrant and joyous occasion of Tet, the Vietnamese Lunar New Year. This month, our focus is on the rich traditions, delicious foods, colorful costumes, and engaging activities that make Tet a special time for everyone.

The children will learn how to make Chung Cake with sticky rice, mung beans, and pork, all wrapped in banana

leaves, symbolizing the Earth. They will also discover Bánh Tét, a cylindrical version of Bánh Chưng, is popular in southern Vietnam and represents the harmony between heaven and earth. We will also share stories and memories of past Tet celebrations to help children understand and appreciate their cultural heritage.
